

### Wrap Around Care (WAC) Behaviour Policy

At Stramongate Primary School we aim to create a welcoming, caring environment where relationships are based on respect. In our Breakfast Club (BC) and After School Club (ASC) we will continue to support children to be outstanding community members.

To ensure the provision is a warm, welcoming, safe and fun experience for all involved we ask that parents discuss the following principles with their child:

- We will always speak to each other politely and with respect
- We will share and take turns with resources and in play
- We will listen to each other and respect the opinions of others
- We will be kind to others
- We will follow instructions given by an adult.

Strategies that will be used to manage negative behaviours in the setting:

Timeout – a few minutes standing or sitting away from the activity but still under supervision
of the Club staff to think about what went wrong and how it could be better.

#### **Rewarding Positive Behaviour**

- Stickers and praise
- Sharing examples of wonderful behaviour with parents/carers at pick up time.

If a child struggles to follow the principles above staff will inform the parents/carers of any concerns and work together to support the child to be able to engage appropriately in the setting.

Staff will speak to you if:

- They have any concerns
- They have an accident
- Your child has particularly enjoyed an activity
- They need to clarify any information.

You should speak to a staff member if:

- You have any concerns
- You have any questions
- You need to tell us about a change at home
- You have a complaint
- You have any ideas to pass on.

### **The Play Environment**

We aim to provide a rich and varied environment which supports children's learning and development. This gives them the confidence to explore and learn in secure and safe, yet challenging, indoor and outdoor spaces.

#### At WAC this is done through providing:

#### An indoor environment (BC & ASC):

- Which provides a place for activity, rest, eating and playing
- Which includes resources which are appropriate, well maintained and accessible to all children
- Which is planned to be used flexibly with a range of activities provided.

#### An outdoor environment (ASC):


- Which gives the children opportunities for doing things in different ways and on different scales than when indoors
- Which gives the children first-hand contact with weather, seasons and the natural world
- Which gives the children freedom to explore, use their senses and be physically active.

#### An emotional environment (BC & ASC):

- Which is created by all the people in WAC, with adults ensuring that the club is warm, friendly, welcoming and accepting of everyone
- Which offers empathy and support to all children
- Which develops children's confidence and encourages them to try new experiences
- Which enables children to express their feelings in the knowledge that they will be accepted and valued.

#### For children in the EYFS, we will ensure that:

- Additional support is provided if required
- Children are involved in planning the layout of the play environment and help to keep it tidy
- Children have opportunities to be outside on a daily basis
- Children are helped to understand how to behave appropriately.
